COLOR Lightly crystalline, with greenish highlights.

NOSE Very elegant, fine, and fresh. Citrus notes appear, such as lime, and are accompanied by aromatic flowers. A light mineral edginess in the background contributes complexity.

PALATE Crisp, lush, balanced, and ripe. A delicate balance between intense citric acidity and alcohol for a juicy, mouth-filling wine. Elegantly persistent with a very pleasing, clean finish.
